### Transfer Admission Procedures/Qualifications

#### Application:

Application can be completed online with the assistance of a Rasmussen College program manager. Application deadlines are rolling based on start date prospective students are interested in with start dates available at multiple times a year. An attestation of high school graduation or equivalency must be provided.

#### Transfer Qualifications: ACT/SAT Scores:

ACT and SAT scores are not required for transfer students.

#### Transcript Evaluations:

Official evaluation is not made until all transcripts are received and enrollment Agreement is completed. However, unofficial and "estimate" reviews can be done before this stage.

#### Estimated Tuition/Fees/Expenses for the 2014-2015 Academic Year Tuition:
